



## 2019 NCRI Excellence Awards

### Application questions

Information for the awards application process can be found below, please review this document before starting an application form.

If the application is a team nomination or a nomination for someone else you will be asked to provide their information (name, Job title, Organisation and email address) please make sure that you seek permission from them before completing the application.

Different questions will be asked depending which award is selected:

#### **Collaboration Award**

This award recognises an individual or team who have collaborated across organisations, brought together interdisciplinary expertise or entered into a novel partnership (e.g. academics with pharmaceutical companies, biotech companies, patients and carers, non-profit organisations, research funders and/or others) to achieve an outcome that would not have been possible if the partnership had not been created.

- 1) Please outline how the individual or team you are nominating have collaborated across organisations or brought together expertise / entered a novel partnership. Please explain how the individual / team members have contributed to this project and describe who is/was involved in this partnership, when it was established and what it was set out to achieve. (up to 300 words)
- 2) Please outline what the partnership has achieved in the last 5 years and why it has made a difference to cancer research. This part should include an explanation of any reasons why this work could not have been done or the same outcome could not have been achieved without establishing this partnership. (up to 300 words)
- 3) Please summarise in one sentence why this individual/team is worthy of recognition and should be awarded the Collaboration Award.

#### **Impact Award**

This award recognises an individual/ team whose research has made an outstanding contribution to the progress of cancer research (e.g. in our understanding of cancer cells / pathways implicated in cancer, development of new therapeutics, delivery of clinical trials, patient recruitment, patient outcomes, policy, service delivery, quality of life).

- 1) Please describe the work that the individual/team you are nominating have undertaken in the last 5 years and the impact this work has had on cancer research. (up to 300 words)
- 2) Please describe how this work has contributed to the progress of cancer research, who has benefitted from it and how it has made a difference in the last 5 years. (up to 300 words)
- 3) Please summarise in one sentence why this individual or team is worthy of recognition and should be awarded the Impact Award.



## **Innovation Award**

This award recognises an individual or team who have developed a cutting-edge idea or a creative approach to answer a research question (e.g. a new trial design, a new technology, a novel methodology, a new drug, a new application to an existing method etc.).

- 1) Please outline what this idea or approach entails, how and when this work is, will or have been undertaken and what is the expected outcome (up to 300 words)
- 2) Please explain why this approach or idea is innovative and how it differs from other approaches utilised before (up to 300 words)
- 3) Please summarise in one sentence why this individual or team is worthy of recognition and should be awarded the Innovation Award.
