

## 2019 NCRI Schools Event and Competition Terms & Conditions

1. The 2019 NCRI Schools Event (“the event”) and competition (“the competition”) are run by the National Cancer Research Institute (“NCRI”) whose charity registration number is 1160609 and registered office is at Angel Building, 407 St John Street, London EC1V 4AD.
2. The competition is open to secondary schools based in the United Kingdom who are able to commit to attend the event taking place in Glasgow at SEC on Tuesday 5 November 2019.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter the competition and take part in the event. Each participating school will be able to register up to four pupils and one teacher.
4. Pupils registered to attend the event must be aged between 16-18 year old.
5. It is the participating school’s responsibility to seek and obtain relevant permission from pupils’ families before taking part in the competition and the event.

7. The competition takes place on Twitter, therefore to be able to enter it, schools or one of their representatives must have a twitter account that needs to be detailed during the registration process.
8. Only one entry will be accepted per school. Multiple entries from the same school will be disqualified and only the first entry will be accepted.
9. Closing date for entry is Monday 23 September 2019. Entries should be submitted on twitter using #NCRI2019\_Schools and #ReachOutReporter and tagging @ncri\_partners @Reach\_Out\_UK between Monday 16 and Monday 23 September 2019. Entries submitted before or after this date range will not be considered.
10. The NCRI takes no responsibility for entries not received for whatever reason nor for the content shared online and included in such entries.
11. The NCRI might request that an entry is deleted by the entrant if deemed offensive, inappropriate or unsuitable as it sees fit.

12. The NCRI reserves the right to cancel or amend the event/competition and these terms and conditions without notice in case of force majeure or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other reasons as the NCRI sees fit. Any changes to the competition or the event will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the NCRI.
13. The NCRI is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
14. The prize will consist of a trophy and some STEM materials for the winning school.
15. The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and the NCRI reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
16. Finalists will be shortlisted by a panel selected by the NCRI and the entries will be subjected to a popular vote conducted live via Twitter during day 1 and 2 of the 2019 NCRI Cancer Conference (<https://conference.ncri.org.uk>) and during the event. Votes will be measured, recorded and verified by the NCRI.
17. The NCRI's decision with respect to all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence about it will be entered into.
18. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by English law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
19. The winner agrees to the use of his/her school's name and image in any publicity material, as well as their entry. Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.
20. Entry into the competition and registration to the event will be deemed as acceptance of these terms and conditions.
